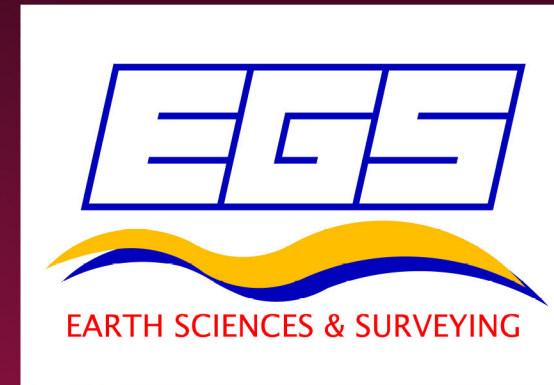
Dear Guests,
